My work is principally based on the relationship between human beings necessities and nature. I'm interested in the forced mutation of natural elements in relation to humans desires and how these permanent changes are related to politics, wealth, genders, social roles and identity where the history layers are determined by fashion trends.

I'm fascinated by abandoned common objects used in design, decoration and utilities one built with a big pulse of desire and then let at the mercyn of their fate. Fragile elements like glass vases come to us and preserved during the years because of the delicacy of the owners are bearers of a great sense of conservation. All of these elements, once used or out of fashion trends suddenly become rubbish. My work is to recover these objects and create new forced relationships and stories by giving them new identities. For sculptures and installations I use principally natural materials or found objects from different origins.

For paintings I'm interested visually in predation scenes and I use markers, testosterone and pure adrenaline. These materials are connected to the chemical substances that are released by the animals brain during the predation and coupling in wild nature as well as they are released everyday by human beings brain when we are in relation with other people at work, in our families etc. I'm interested in this specific moment where the natural pulses that can determine the life or the death are in contrast with social world build on barriers and constructs.
